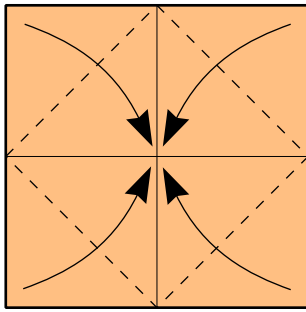


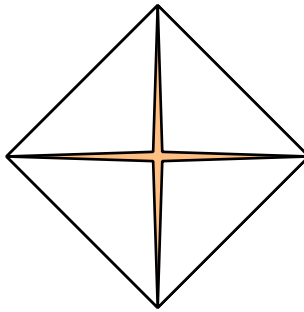
Squirrel (1/2)

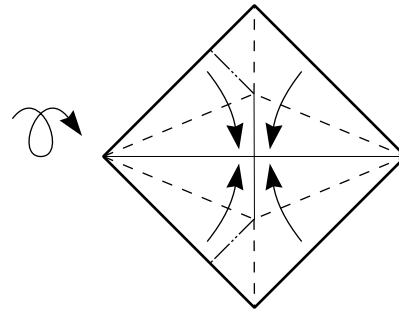

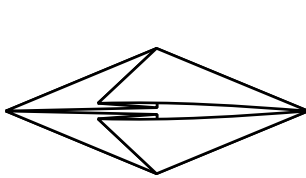
1) Blintz-fold.



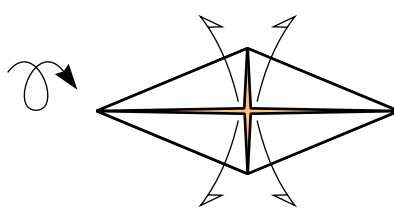
2) Turn over.



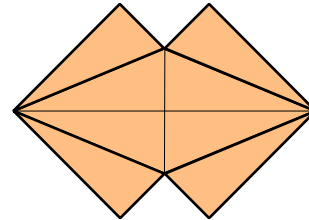
3) Rabbit ear on the upper and lower corner (basic fish fold).



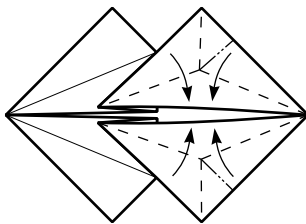
4) Turn over.



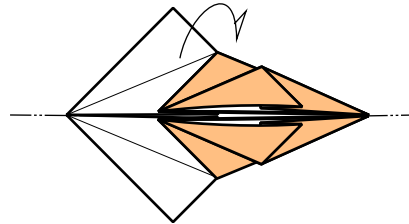
5) Open flaps.



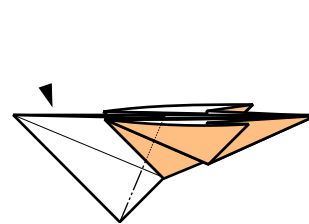
6) Turn over.



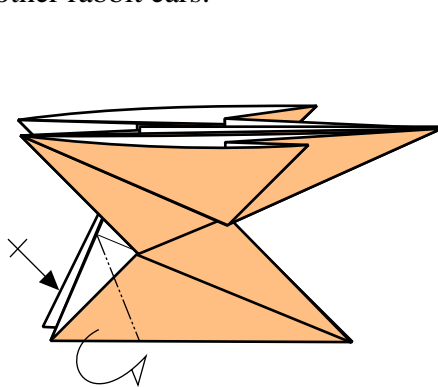
7) Turtle base. Make another rabbit ears.



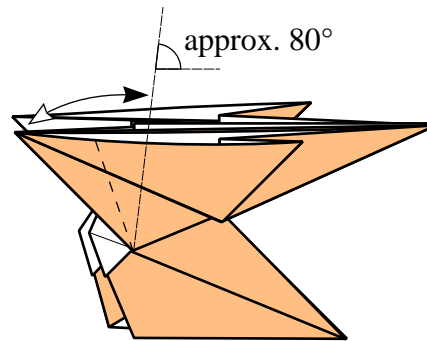
8) Fold in half.



9) Reverse-fold.



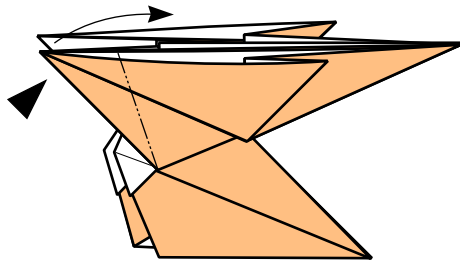
10) Fold corners inwards.



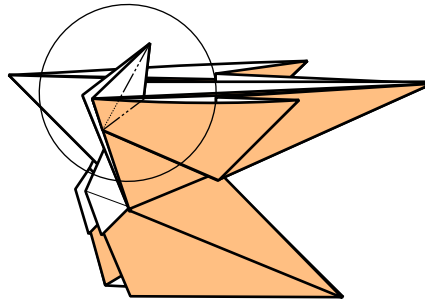
11) Fold to the indicated line. Angle should be slightly smaller than 90° to make the squirrel stand. Unfold.

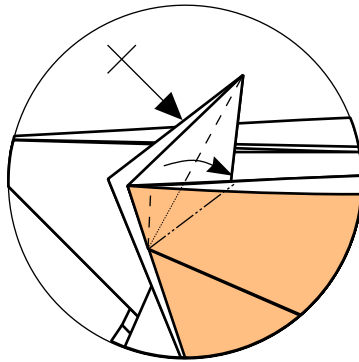

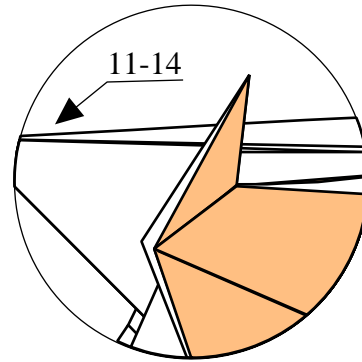
12) Reverse-fold.



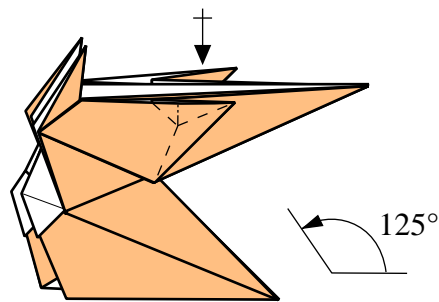
13) Detailed view.



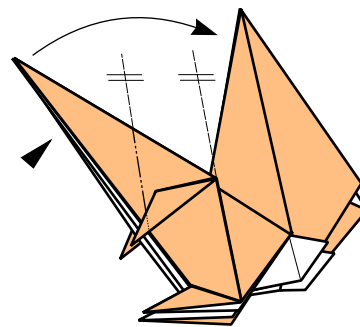
14) Complete double-rabbit ear, following indicated creases.



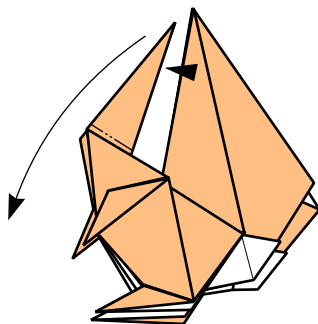
15) Repeat steps 11-14 behind.



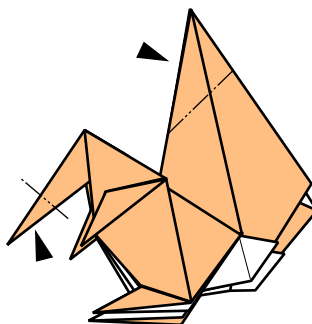
16) Rabbit ear.
Repeat behind.



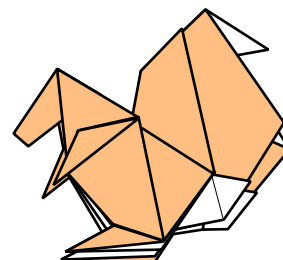
17) Reverse-fold following indicated crease.
