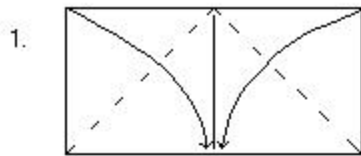


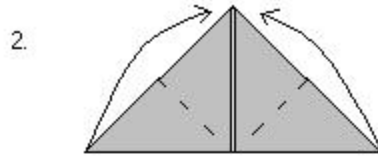
# Butterfly - Collin Weber

Use a 2x1 rectangle with a different color on each side.

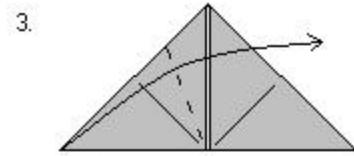
Start with the side with the color you want to be the wings. The other color will be the head and body.



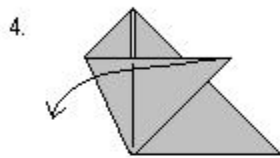
1. 2 valley folds to the center



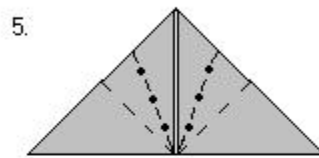
2. 2 valley folds and unfold



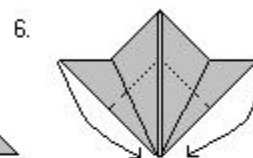
3. Valley fold to the right lining up the crease made in step 2 with the center line.



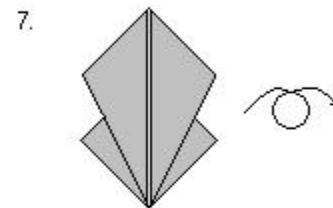
4. Unfold  
Repeat steps 3 and 4 on the right



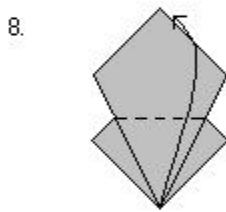
5. Reverse fold in and out on each side



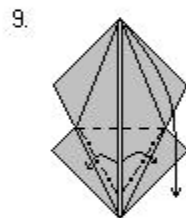
6. 2 reverse folds



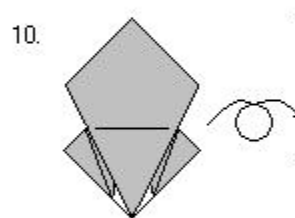
7. Turn over



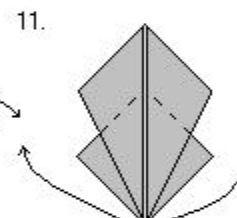
8. Fold the point up to the top like a petal fold



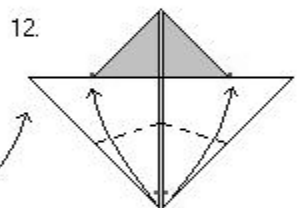
9. Fold the point back down while sliding some paper out on each side



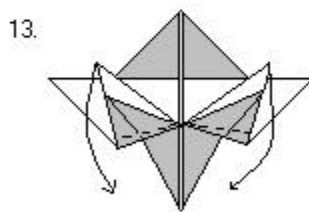
10. Turn over



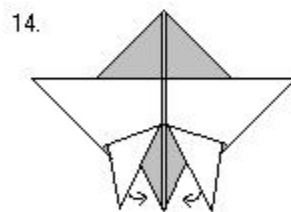
11. Fold the 2 points up



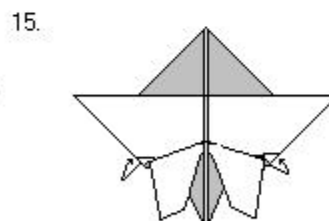
12. Valley fold the 2 bottom points up so that the dots line up



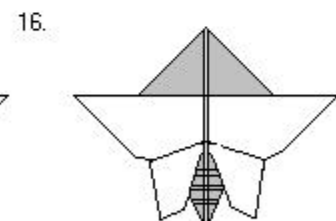
13. 2 valley folds



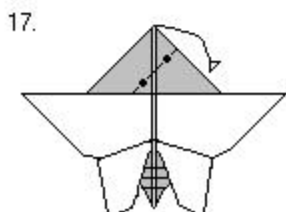
14. Pull some paper out on each side



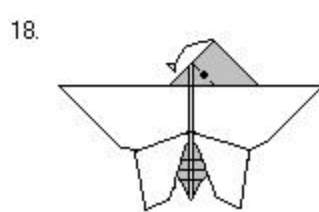
15. 2 mountain folds



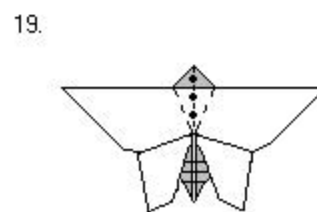
16. 3 pleats on the body



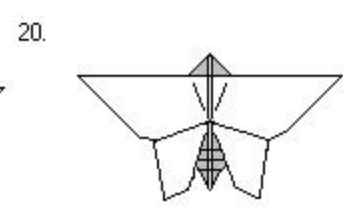
17. Fold behind

19. Add these folds to finish the head
