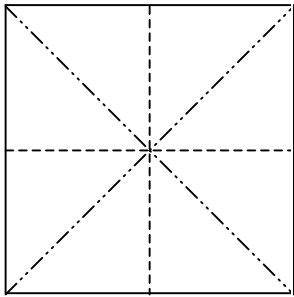


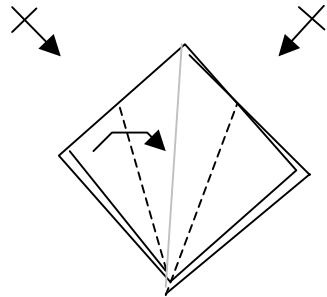

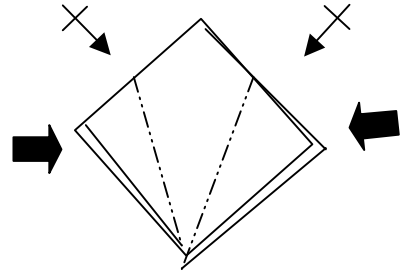
1. Formar base preliminar. (fold nreliminar base)



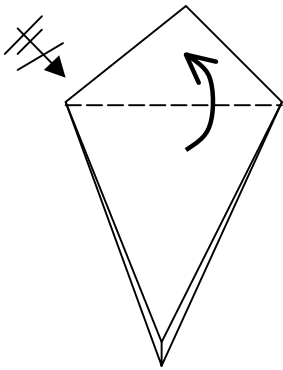
2. Pliegues en valle para formar base pájaro. (Make valley folds to center line. Repeat behind)



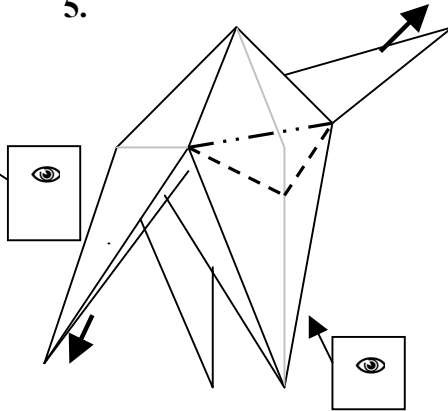

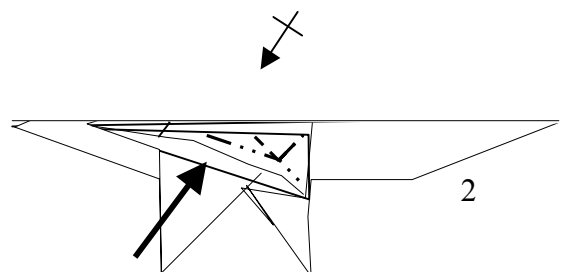
14. Doblar en monte y girar modelo.

(Mountain fold, repeat behind)

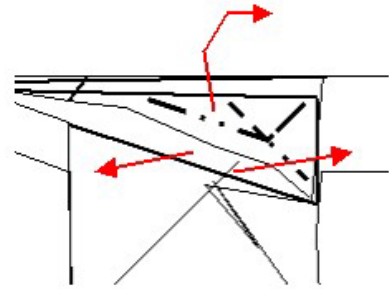


16. Abrir la punta para formar las alas. (Open the wings using the pocket. Repeat behind)

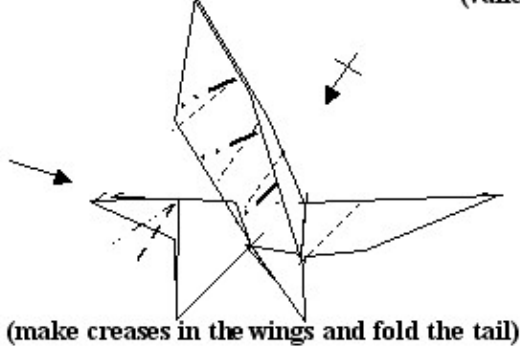

Abrir ala por el bolsillo interior y aplastar por base, dando forma a las ala. **(Open the pocket and squash the wing base. Repeat behind)**

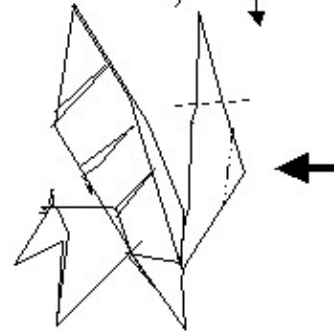


17. Dar forma a las alas.

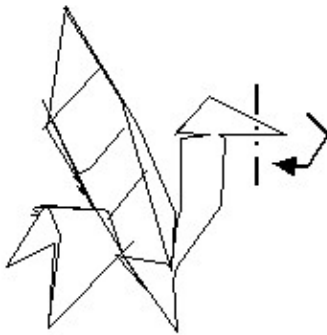

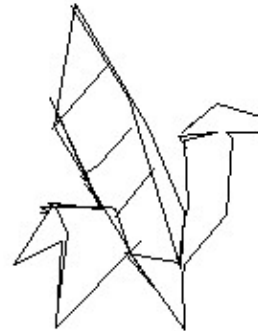
18. Pliegue invertido para formar la cabeza. Hundido en el cuello (valley fold to make head; sink fold)
